DIRECTIONS TO GREENWICH CLUB

Decorative Trims and Edgings



Lyn will select from her repertoire of fine hand sewing techniques to develop a fun class specifically for RISN members. Under Lyn's tutelage, participants will experiment with a variety of trims, edge embellishments, and thread embroidery techniques which give quality garments a special and unique touch. We will explore the possibilities for creating individual trims, edgings, and hem treatments. These techniques can be applied to garment necklines, collars, baby clothes, and lingerie, or a special project inspired by your personal creativity.

The class is suitable for beginner level and above and will follow a notebook/sample format. With the aid of a diagrammed workbook, participants will gain inspiration and confidence to try these techniques on their next project after class.

There is no pre-class preparation required as all techniques will be stitched using the pre-cut kit pieces. Please bring your personal **hand sewing** tools.
